## UPLIFT THE PARSONAGE UPDATE

Thank you to all of our members who have generously contributed to our Uplift the Parsonage campaign. The contributions to date have kept pace with the incurred bills. Forthcoming contributions will be critical to addressing our expenses. A lot of improvements have already been completed.

Completed projects include:

- The elimination of the mold in the furnace room which has been professionally addressed and corrected.
- The installation of central air conditioning in the parsonage and apartment.

Projects currently underway include:

- The replacement of the enclosed porch.
- The relocation of the laundry room to the upstairs.
- The pouring of a new cement floor in the garage.

Following the completion of the porch the focus of the project will move inside as the three bathrooms are renovated. Your generosity has and will greatly contribute toward the completion of this project.

# COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- The cell tower closing took place in August and the first of 4 annual payments has been made.
- Repairs and improvements to the parsonage are moving forward, and financial gifts continue to be received.
